Russell Ballard, and he talked about being master communicators and being completely confident in our knowledge of the Gospel so we could teach well. Rumor has it that we are hearing from another Apostle this upcoming week and possibly another after that. Heard that we were hearing from 4 in a row or 5 so we'll figure it out. On Wednesday I got to be a host missionary for the missionaries coming in this week, unfortunately I didn't get to be the host for Mike, but I did get to see him once.
