This past Saturday I was at the church and there was a goodbye party for 2 missionaries leaving from the ward: Cleiton and Benicio. The old Bishop here gave a short message about D+C 4, which was a good reminder. I need to study more of the Doctrine and Covenants. Also hearing their testimonies before leaving for the mission was a reminder of myself when I left for the mission. Last sunday I heard Cleiton's farewell talk.

A funny thing that happened, I taught class in Church last Sunday. Elder Alonso called me Elder Jonas because I kept looking for opportunities to delay it. Well the Lord wanted me to teach the Gospel Principles class. This past week a member recieved the calling to teach it, it took 5 months for that to happen. Haha.

I'll try to send those sometime soon. Just a funny thing that happened that I had forgotten to talk about.

Also maybe a small lego set or something. I don't know i will think more this next week, but i haven't been able to think of many things. Love you all very much. I am glad to hear you are all doing well. I am glad to hear Geoff and Kelly got sealed this past week! I got an email from them. Still haven't had an opportunity to mail letters... Maybe next week. We have the plan for going to Centro again, all depends on Transfers.

Hump Day is coming! O_o doesn't feel like I am one year out on the mission yet, well almost. The days have gotten slower recently. Hope this email was long enough.
