So like I said last week, we both had colds when we were giving our talks, however, I got better rather quickly, but Elder Helamã is still a little sick. So I talked to him in English, well tried. As I started, I would say stuff in Portuguese without meaning to. Then when he would reply to the questions I asked in English, I had a few difficulties understanding a few of the answers he gave because I kept thinking I heard words in Portuguese. It was just a funny experience.
